ORDER

1. This joint petition has been filed under sections 230-232 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) by the petitioner companies seeking sanction of this Tribunal to a scheme of arrangement for amalgamation of M/s 3B Blackbio Biotech India Limited (Transferor Company) with M/s Kilpest India Limited (Transferee Company) and their respective Shareholders and Creditors (hereinafter referred to as the "Scheme").

2. It is stated that both the petitioner companies are situated in the State of Madhya Pradesh. Hence, both petitioner companies are under the jurisdiction of the National Company Law Tribunal Bench at Indore.

3. The petitioner companies filed a joint Company Application CA (CAA) No. 02 of 2022 before this Bench, seeking directions for the convening of meeting of equity shareholders of the transferee company and dispensation of meetings of equity shareholders, secured creditors, and unsecured creditors of the transferor company and dispensation of meetings of secured creditors and unsecured creditors of the transferee company. This Tribunal vide order dated 10.06.2022 dispensed the meetings of the equity shareholders of the transferor company and secured creditors of the transferee company. Further, it was directed to convene the meetings of equity shareholders and unsecured creditors of the transferee company. However, there were no secured creditors and unsecured creditors in the transferor company, so no meeting was required to be convened. Mr. Shrikant Kesharwani and Mr. Praveen Kumar Rai were appointed as the Chairman and Scrutinizer respectively for the meetings.

4. By the order dated 10.06.2022, passed in CA(CAA) No. 02 of 2022, this Tribunal had directed the petitioner companies to serve notice(s) of the scheme in compliance with section 230(5) of the Companies Act, 2013 to (i) the Central Government through the Regional Director; (ii) the Registrar of Companies, Gwalior; (iii) the concerned Income Tax Authority

and (iv) the Official Liquidator stating that representations, if any, to be made within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of such notice, and in case no representation is received by the Tribunal within the stipulated period of 30 days, it should be presumed that the authorities have no representation to make. In compliance with the order dated 10.06.2022, the petitioner companies served notices to the Central Government through the Regional Director, the Registrar of Companies, the concerned Income Tax Authorities, and the Official Liquidator.

5. Chairman report dated 07.11.2022 for the meetings of equity shareholders and unsecured creditors of the transferee company is placed on record. The meetings were held on 02.11.2022 in which a Special Resolution for approval of the scheme was unanimously passed.

6. The petitioner companies have jointly filed the present petition CP(CAA) No. 08 of 2022 before this Bench seeking sanction of the proposed scheme of arrangement for amalgamation. This Tribunal, by order dated 24.11.2022 admitted the aforesaid petition and directed the issuance of notice(s) to the Regional Director, Registrar of Companies, Official Liquidator, and Income Tax Authority informing the date of hearing.

This Tribunal also directed the publication of notice of hearing of the petition in newspapers ("Swadesh" in Hindi and "Financial Express" in English) not less than 10 days before the fixed date of hearing, calling for objection, if any, on or before the date of hearing.

In compliance with the order dated 24.11.2022, the petitioner companies served the notice(s) of hearing to the authorities. Further, the notice of hearing of the petition was published as per the order of the Tribunal. The affidavit of service and publication along with necessary proof of service is filed and the same is placed on record.

7. In response to the notice received from the petitioner companies, the Official Liquidator (OL) has submitted his separate report dated

09.02.2023 with respect to the petitioner companies wherein the OL has made the following observations:

(i) At para 11, OL has observed that object of the transferor company is not covered under the object of the transferee company.

(ii) At para 12, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferor company to place on record all the relevant facts of the shareholder which was incorporated under the laws of Spain, and has gone into liquidation and how exit route will be provided to the shareholders for which consent for the scheme is not received.

(iii) At para 13, OL has observed that a correction in Clause 6(n) of the scheme of merger may be required where the word 'transferee' is to be replaced with 'transferor' for creation of securities in favor of transferee company.

(iv) At para 14, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferor company to clarify the issue with regard to declaration of dividend.

(v) At para 15, OL has observed that the transferor company is going to be dissolved after sanctioning of the scheme, the treatment of all the employees including temporary/other employees after amalgamation should be disclosed in the scheme.

(vi) At para 18, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferor company to disclose relevant documents of patents or trademarks registered in its name.

(vii) At para 19, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferee company to preserve the books of accounts and other records of the transferor company.

(viii) At para 20, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferee company to comply with the requirements of the

Accounting Standards under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.

(ix) At para 21, OL has prayed that directions may be given to the transferee company to ensure statutory compliance of all applicable laws.

Submissions made by the petitioner companies in response to the observations of the Official Liquidator are as follows:

(i) In response to the observation at para 11 of the OL, the petitioner companies have stated that clause no. 19 of the scheme reads as follows:

“it is clarified that the approval of the members of the transferee company to the scheme shall be deemed to be their consent/approval also to the alteration of the Memorandum and Articles of Association of the transferee company as may be required under the Act.”

It is further submitted that the transferee company carried out an amendment in the Articles of Association during the year 2008 vide Annual General Meeting dated 30.09.2008 and as per the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, thereby, inserting clause ‘C’ in the main objects of the company.

(ii) In response to the observation at para 12 of the OL, the petitioner companies have stated that M/s 2B Blackbio S.L. Spain, company (in liquidation) will be issued shares in physical form as per the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013.

(iii) In response to the observation at para 13 of the OL, the petitioner companies have stated that clause No. 6 (transfer of undertaking) sub-clause ‘n’ deals only with the securities created in favor of the only secured creditor i.e. State Bank of India, on the assets of the transferee company, the last paragraph of the same is reproduced below:

“However, if subsequent to the scheme being placed before the authorities for approval, if no liabilities towards any bank or financial institution continues, the securities over such assets of the transferee company, if any created will be released and such assets of the transferee company would be free from any charges, if any.”

The transfer of assets of the transferor company with or without securities created over them is dealt in sub-clause ‘l’ and ‘m’. It is submitted that since there are no secured creditors and no security is created on the assets of the transferor company as such the assets will be transferred freely to the transferee company.

(iv) In response to the observation at para 14 of the OL, the transferee company stated that the scheme clearly states that the transferor company and the transferee company shall not declare or pay dividends, which are interim or final to the respective members relating to any period commencing or after the appointed date unless agreed by the Board of Directors of the transferor company and the transferee company. The consent of the Board of Directors has been already obtained.

(v) In response to the observation at para 15 of the OL, the transferee company stated that in point 16 of the scheme, it is mentioned that the service of employees of the transferor company will be treated as having been continuous for the purpose of the aforesaid schemes/funds. Further, the transferee company undertakes to comply with the same.

(vi) In response to the observation at para 18 of the OL, the transferee company submitted the relevant documents relating to patent and trademark in its affidavit in reply to the observations of the OL.

(vii) In response to the observation at para 19 of the OL, the transferee company undertakes to preserve the books of accounts and other documents of the transferor company.

(viii) In response to the observation at para 20 of the OL, the transferee company undertakes to comply with the requirements of the Accounting Standards under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.

(ix) In response to the observation at para 21 of the OL, the transferee company undertakes to comply with all the applicable laws.

7. In response to the notice served upon the Regional Director (RD) and the Registrar of Companies (ROC), a combined representation was filed by the RD dated 21.12.2022, wherein the RD has made the following observations:

(i) At para (d), the RD has observed that the SEBI circulars issued on 04.02.2013, 21.05.2013 and 10.03.2017 are intended to ensure compliance by listed company in the interest of shareholders at large. This office is of the view that the said SEBI circulars are applicable, and the transferee company should comply with the requirements of the said circular.

(ii) At para (g), the RD has prayed that directions may be given to the petitioner companies to ensure the compliance of FEMA and RBI guidelines, in the matter.

(iii) At para (h), the RD has observed that in the scheme at para 16, it is stated that upon the scheme coming into force, all permanent employees of the transferor company shall become employees of the transferee company. In this regard, RD prayed that directions may be given to the transferee company to consider not only the permanent employees but all the employees of the transferor company.

(iv) At para (i), the RD has prayed that directions may be given to the transferee company to follow the process of the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013/1956 and rules made thereunder with regard to the change of the name of the company.

(v) At para (e), the RD has observed that from the secured charge index of the transferee company maintained in MCA portal that there are 16 secured charges. Therefore, the transferee company needs to place on record all the relevant facts of the matter.

(vi) ROC in the report dated 12.12.2022 submitted that there is a complaint made by Shri Sushil Garg vide SRN J0007712 dated 22.08.2022, which is pending for ROC's action.

Submissions made by the petitioner companies in response to the observations of the Regional Director are as follows:

(i) In response to the observation made in para (d) of the RD, the transferee company submitted that it has complied with the observations of SEBI and BSE.

(ii) In response to the observation made in para (g) of the RD, it is submitted that the petitioner companies have complied with the provisions of FEMA and RBI guidelines.

(iii) In response to the observation made in para (h) of the RD, the transferee company has submitted that all employees including the permanent employees of the transferor company will be deemed to be in continuous service without any break on the same terms and conditions.

(iv) In response to the observation made in para (e) of the RD, the transferee company submitted that State Bank of Indore has ceased to exist from April 2010 and was merged with State Bank of India, and hence fresh charges were created in favor of State Bank of India. The consent of State Bank of India was already submitted

to the RD. It is further submitted that the 20th Century Finance Corporation Ltd has merged with Centurian Bank Ltd which has subsequently merged with HDFC Bank Ltd. Further, all the loans obtained from Centurian Bank Ltd have been repaid, however, there is no officer available from Centurian Bank Ltd to confirm the same. The letter of settlement is attached and the same is placed on record.

(v) In response to the observation made in para (i) of the RD, the transferee company submitted that subject to what is stated under the single window principle the petitioner companies will file the forms and pay the fees for change of name.

(vi) In response to the observation made in the ROC report, it is submitted by the petitioner companies that the complaint filed by Mr. Sushil Garg is no longer pending as the said complaint has been resolved.

8. In response to the notice received from the petitioner companies, the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of Income Tax has submitted his separate report dated 07.03.2023 with respect to the petitioner companies. It was submitted that there is an outstanding arrear demand for only one year for the A.Y. 2018-19 for Rs 5,84,526/- with respect to the transferor company and Rs 15,52,179/- is pending as arrear with respect to the transferee company. Further, it was prayed that this Bench may seek a certificate/undertaking from the petitioner companies to settle all dues of the Income Tax Department.

Submissions made by the petitioner companies in response to the observations of the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of Income Tax are as follows:

(i) In response to the pending dues with respect to the transferor company it is submitted that the company has received an order under section 154 of the Income Tax Act along with a

demand notice reflecting NIL demand for the A.Y. 2018-19. Copy of the same placed on record.

(ii) In response to the pending dues with respect to the transferee company it is submitted that several dues were paid in full and the same was deposited vide challan, and for the remaining an appeal was made by the transferee company before the CIT(A) which was decided in favor of the company. Further, it is undertaken by the transferee company to pay the Income Tax dues which are legally due and payable.

Regional Director as well as the Official Liquidator also submitted that the related legal fees/expenses, for submitting the report and representing the matter may be paid by the petitioner companies.

9. Considering the above reply filed by the petitioner companies, the observations made by the Regional Director, the representation of the Official Liquidator, and the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of Income Tax stand satisfied.

10. It has been submitted by the learned advocate appearing for the petitioner companies that the Scheme is not against public policy. It has also been stated that it will not adversely impact any secured or unsecured creditors of the petitioner companies. It has also been submitted that all statutory obligations under all applicable laws shall be complied with.

11. Supreme Court **Miheer H. Mafatlal vs Mafatlal Industries Ltd JT 1996 (8) 205** while considering the scope of the jurisdiction of the Company Court in respect of matters of sanction of the scheme of Amalgamation as per the provisions of section 391 read with section 393 of the Companies Act, 1956, observed as under:

It is the commercial wisdom of the parties to the scheme who have taken an informed decision about the usefulness and propriety of the scheme by supporting it by the requisite majority vote that has to be

kept in view by the Court. The Court certainly would not act as a court of appeal and sit in judgment over the informed view of the concerned parties to the compromise as the same would be in the realm of corporate and commercial wisdom of the concerned parties. The Court has neither the expertise nor the jurisdiction to delve deep into the commercial wisdom exercised by the creditors and members of the company who have ratified the scheme by the requisite majority. Consequently, the Company Court's jurisdiction to that extent is peripheral and supervisory and not appellate.

In view of the law laid down by the Supreme Court, this Tribunal is not supposed to examine the merits/benefits of the commercial wisdom of the decision of the shareholders etc.

12. On the basis of the above facts and submissions made by the learned advocate and after considering the entire facts and circumstances of the aforesaid company petition and on perusal of the scheme and the proceedings, it is noted that the requirements of the provisions of section 230 and 232 are satisfied by the petitioner companies. As a result, Company Petition No. CP (CAA) No. 08 of 2022 is allowed. The Scheme envisages the amalgamation of M/s 3B Blackbio Biotech India Limited (Transferor Company) with M/s Kilpest India Limited (Transferee Company) is hereby sanctioned. The said scheme will have to be effective from the date of appointment i.e. 01.04.2020 as set out in the scheme. It is declared that the said sanctioned scheme shall be binding on the petitioner companies and their shareholders, creditors, and all concerned under the scheme.

13. Notwithstanding the above, if there is any deficiency found or, violation committed qua any enactment, statutory rule, or regulation, the sanction granted by this Tribunal to the scheme will not come in the way of action being taken, albeit, in accordance with the law, against the concerned persons, directors and officials of the petitioner companies.

14. While approving the Scheme as above, we further clarify that this order should not be construed as an order in granting any exemption from payment of stamp duty, taxes including Income Tax, GST, etc., or any other charges if any, and payment in accordance with law or in respect of any permission/compliance with any other requirement which may be specifically required under any law. It is further clarified that Income Tax Department will be free to examine the aspect of any tax payable as a result of the sanction of the scheme and sanction of the scheme of amalgamation given hereunder shall not adversely affect the rights of the Income Tax Department on any past, present, or future proceedings.

15. This Tribunal order as under:

ORDER

I. The scheme of arrangement envisaging the amalgamation of M/s 3B Blackbio Biotech India Limited (Transferor Company) with M/s Kilpest India Limited (Transferee Company) as annexed herewith as **“Annexure A”** is hereby sanctioned and it is declared that the same shall be binding on the petitioner companies and their shareholders and creditors and all concerned under the Scheme.

II. It is declared that the transferor company shall be dissolved without winding up.

III. All the property annexed herewith as **“Annexure B”**, rights and power of the transferor company specified in the schedule hereto, and all the other property, rights, and powers of the transferor company be transferred without further act or deed to the transferee company.

IV. All the liabilities and duties of the transferor company be transferred without further act or deed to the transferee company

and accordingly the same shall pursuant to section 232 of the Act become the liabilities and duties of the transferee company.

V. All proceedings, if any, now pending or against the transferor company be continued by or against the transferee company.

VI. The petitioner companies within thirty days of the date of receipt of this order, cause a certified copy of this order to be delivered to the Registrar of Companies for registration, and on such certified copy being so delivered, the entire undertaking of the transferor company shall stand transferred to the transferee company and the Registrar of Companies shall place all documents relating to the transferor company to the file kept by him in relation to the transferee company and the files relating to the said companies shall be treated accordingly.

VII. The petitioner companies are further directed to file a copy of this order along with a copy of the Scheme with the concerned Registrar of Companies, electronically, along with e-form INC-28 in addition to a physical copy within 30 days from the date of issuance of the certified copy of the Order by the Registry as per relevant provisions of the Act.

VIII. All concerned Authorities to act on a copy of this order along with the Scheme authenticated by the Registrar of this Tribunal, and the Registrar shall issue the certified copy of this order along with the Scheme immediately.

IX. The petitioner companies are directed to lodge a copy of this Order and the approved Scheme and Schedule of Assets of the transferor companies attached as **Annexure-B** with this order, duly authenticated by the Registrar of this Tribunal, with the concerned Superintendent of Stamps, for the purpose of adjudication of stamp duty, if any, within 60 days from the date of the Order.

X. The legal fees and expenses of the office of the Regional Director are quantified at Rs 10,000/- with respect to the petitioner companies. The said fees to the Regional Director shall be paid by the transferee company.

XI. The legal fees and expenses of the office of the Official Liquidator are quantified at Rs 10,000/- with respect to the petitioner transferor company. The said fees to the Official Liquidator shall be paid by the transferee company.

XII. The Income Tax Department will be free to examine the aspect of any tax payable as a result of the sanction of the scheme and if it is found that the scheme of arrangement ultimately results in tax avoidance or is not in accordance with the applicable provisions of Income Tax Act, then the Income Tax Department shall be at liberty to initiate appropriate course of action as per law. Any sanction of the scheme of arrangement under sections 230-232 of the Companies Act, 2013 shall not adversely affect the rights of the Income Tax Department or any past, present or future proceedings and the sanction of the scheme shall not come in its way for the appropriate course of action as per law for the tax liabilities, if any.

16. Any person aggrieved shall be at liberty to apply to the Tribunal in the above matter for any direction that may be necessary.

17. The Company Petition CP (CAA) No. 08 of 2022 connected with CA (CAA) No. 02 of 2022 is disposed of. No order as to costs.

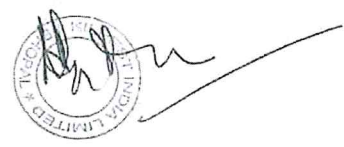
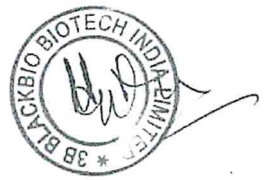
1. PREAMBLE

This Scheme of Amalgamation is presented under Sections 230 to 232 and other applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 & the Rules framed thereunder including any statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof, if any, for the amalgamation of 3B BLACKBIO BIOTECH INDIA LIMITED (Company Registration No.: 024717 and having CIN:U24232MP2010PTC024717) defined as "the Transferor Company" with KILPEST INDIA LIMITED (Company Registration No.: 001131 and having CIN:L24211MP1972PLC001131) defined as "the Transferee Company" and in compliance with the conditions relating to "Amalgamation" as specified u/s 2(1B) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and the same is divided into the following parts

- (a) The Transferor Company was incorporated on 12th November, 2010 as a Private Limited Company under the Companies Act, 1956 under the name and style of "3B BLACKBIO BIOTECH INDIA LIMITED" as per the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies, Gwalior The Transferor Company is engaged in the business of manufacturer in the field of RT-PCR and NGS based Molecular Diagnostic Kits, engaged in design, development, manufacturing and commercialization of PCR based Molecular Diagnostic kits, PCR Enzymes & PCR Reagents. The registered office of the Transferor Company is situated at 7C, Industrial Area, Govindpura, Bhopal, MP-462023. The shares of the Transferor Company are not listed on any stock exchange.
- (b) The Transferee Company was incorporated on 27th May, 1972 as a Private Company under the Companies Act, 1956 under the name and style of "KILPEST PRIVATE LIMITED" as per the Certificate of Incorporation issued by the Registrar of Companies, Gwalior. And then a fresh certificate of incorporation consequent upon change of Name was issued on 6th March, 1995 by the Registrar of Companies, Gwalior and the name was changed from Kilpest Private Limited to Kilpest India Limited. The Transferee Company is engaged in the business of agro-chemicals and is into manufacturing, dealing of pesticides, insecticides, micro fertilizers etc. The shares of the Transferee Company are currently listed on BSE Limited. The registered office of the Transferee Company is presently situated at 7C, Industrial Area, Govindpura , Bhopal, MP-462023

2. RATIONALE OF THE SCHEME

- (a) The Transferor Company is engaged in the business of manufacturer in the field of RT-PCR and NGS based Molecular Diagnostic Kits, also engaged in design, development, manufacturing and commercialization of PCR based Molecular Diagnostic kits, PCR Enzymes & PCR Reagents. The Transferee Company is major shareholder, holding 87.44 % of the issued, subscribed and paid up equity share capital of the Transferor Company. The Transferee Company is engaged in the business as manufacturers of agro-chemicals and is into manufacturing, dealing of pesticides, insecticides, micro fertilizers etc.
- (b) The Transferee Company intends to integrate the operations of the Transferor Company with itself as a part of restructuring process by taking over the manufacturing unit along with its business know-how, market reach, all the tangible and intangible assets
- (c) The Amalgamated Company (defined below) will have greater efficiency in overall business including economies of scale, cash flow management of the amalgamated entity and unfettered access to cash flow generated by the combined business which can be deployed more efficiently for the purpose of development of businesses of the companies and their growth opportunities, eliminate inter corporate dependencies, minimize the administrative compliances, etc. resulting in maximisation of shareholders value.
- (d) Amalgamation will result in cost saving for the Transferor Company and the Transferee Company as they are engaged in the related and interdependent activity which is expected to result in higher net worth and cost savings for the Amalgamated Company.
- (e) The Amalgamated Company will have the benefit of the combined resources of the Transferor Company and the Transferee Company i.e., market share, scale, efficiency, combined net-worth, combined employee base, reserves, investments, and other assets, manpower, consolidated pool of finances, including optimization of borrowing costs and administrative compliances related thereto, larger size, consolidation of operations, mitigating competition, future opportunities, etc. The Amalgamated Company would be in a position to carry on consolidated operations through optimum utilization of its resources and integrated production facilities.

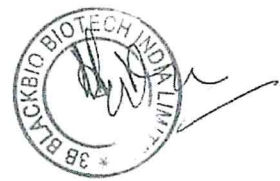
- (f) The Amalgamated Company would also have a larger net-worth base, and greater borrowing capacity since the assets held by transferor companies are free from all encumbrances, which would provide it a competitive edge over others, especially in view of the increasing competition due to liberalization and globalization, which will be beneficial in more than one ways to the Transferor Company and the Transferee Company and their shareholders and creditors, as the Transferor Company and the Transferee Company plan to meet the competition in a more effective way by combining their asset base and operations.
- (g) The Board of Directors of the Transferor Company and the Transferee Company are of the opinion that the amalgamation would motivate employees by providing better opportunities to scale up their performance with a corporate entity having large revenue base, resources, asset base etc which will provide impetus to corporate performance thereby enhancing overall shareholder value.

- (b) In the event that the Transferee Company restructures its equity share capital by way of share split/consolidation/issue of bonus or right shares/ further issue of shares during the pendency of the Scheme, the Share Exchange Ratio as defined in Clause 11 (a) above, shall be adjusted accordingly to take into account the effect of such corporate actions.
