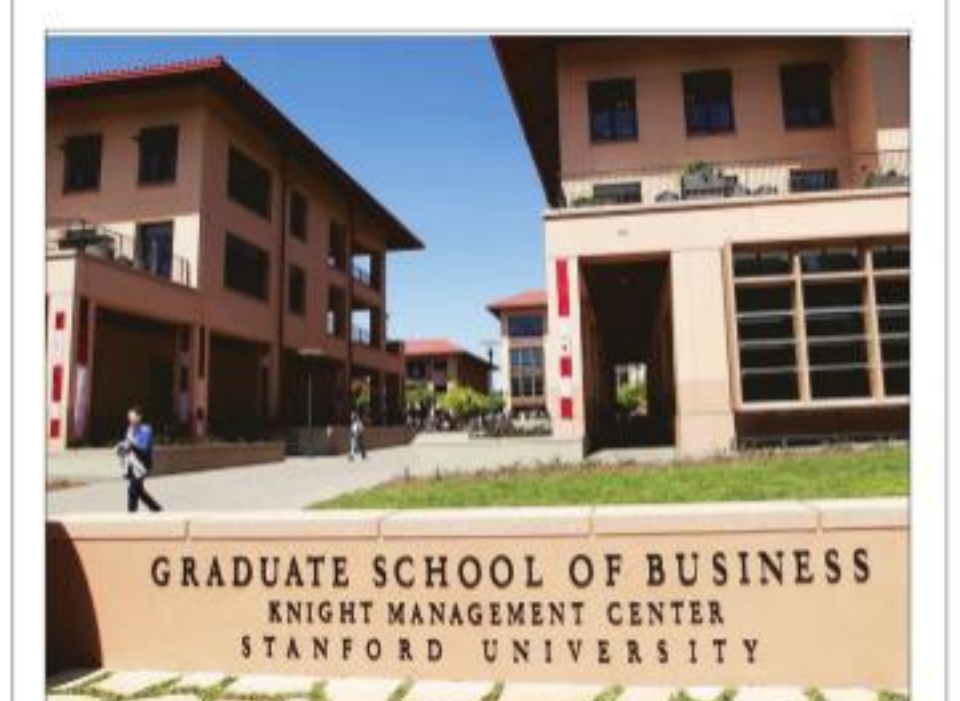

INDIAN BUSINESS SCHOOLS seem to be steadily improving their performance in the QS Global MBA Rankings. In the latest (2023) rankings, the Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad (IIM-A) is best ranked Indian B-school, having climbed up two spots from QS Global MBA 2022 rankings, occupying the 44th spot globally.

ers make their debut in the widely-cited appraisal of business schools, XLRI-Jamshedpur (in the 151-200 band) and Management Development Institute-Gurgaon (201-250). Globally, there wasn't much of a shift in the top five spots this year. They remain dominated by US business schools, with Stanford Graduate School of Business occupying the top spot, and Harvard Business School coming in second, followed by Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania. The list is rounded out by the European contenders, HEC Paris (4th) and London Business School (5th).

PM lays foundation stone for 'world's first CNG terminal'

PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA Modi laid the foundation stone for the "world's first CNG (Compressed Natural Gas) terminal" at Bhavnagar in Gujarat on Thursday.

During his two-day visit to the poll-bound state, Prime Minister also dedicated various projects, including water supply and drainage projects, DREAM City.

During the occasion, PM said that Indian industries had witnessed the adverse impact of overdependence for containers on other countries. Now it is time to become self-reliant in containers supply and Bhavnagar would take lead in this mission.

"Bhavnagar district is already housing Asia's biggest ship recycling yard near Alang and Alang would reap the maximum advantage once the ship scrapping policy was implemented as ship scrapping expertise of Alang based units could be extended to scrapping of old vehicles instantly. Alang has potential to attract old vehicles not only from India

but also from across the globe," PM said.

The PM mentioned that development of Dholera Special Investment Region (SIR) — as a hub of semiconductor, space and renewable energy would have a positive impact on activities at Bhavnagar port and connected regions. Referring to the Ghogha-Dahej Ro-Ro service, the Prime Minister claimed that till to date, three lakh passengers and 80,000 vehicles have benefited from this service. The use of sea route instead of the 400 km long journey from Bhavnagar to south Gujarat has helped save 40 lakh litres of fossil fuels, he added.

While inaugurating the main entrance of Diamond Research and Mercantile (DREAM) City in Surat earlier, PM said, "Once it's completed, the DREAM City project would make Surat a safe and secure diamond trading hub in the world. Surat's powerloom cluster would also benefit from the Centre's recent approval for Surat Powerloom mega cluster and address the current issues faced by the sector."

Addressing a gathering in Surat, the PM said: "Surat is known as a diamond city, textile city, clean City and smart city. Now it is poised to emerge as an Electric Vehicle (EV) City as the Central and state gov-



ernments are encouraging the use of electric vehicles."

Over twenty EV charging stations have been set up in Surat city, 500 more stations will be started shortly. "Around 80 percent of the public transport vehicles in Surat will be electric in the near future," the PM said.

INDIA CLIMBED SIX notches to 40th position in the Global Innovation Index 2022 on account of improvement in several parameters, according to a report by the Geneva-based World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO). Switzerland, the United States, Sweden, the United Kingdom and the Netherlands are the world's most-

innovative economies, according to WIPO's 2022 Global Innovation Index (GII), with China on the threshold of the top 10. Other emerging economies are also showing consistently strong performance, including India and Turkey, both of which enter the top 40 for the first time. "Canada is back among the top 15 global innovators (15th), Türkiye (37th) and India (40th) enter the top 40 for the first time."
